Aim Communication in strategic situations may potentially serve a variety of purposes such as coordination, persuasion, commitment or the exchange of private information. The symposium will be an effort to further the insights from research on communication in strategic settings to new groups of economists and to provide a forum for scholars in this research area to exchange ideas and results. Researchers within the field are encouraged to submit theoretic or experimental work.

Call for papers Abstracts (not more than 500 words) should be sent as pdf files to the symposium secretaries by April 30, 2007. Those interested in participating without presenting a paper should contact the symposium secretaries before May 31, 2007.

Format Both days will mainly be dedicated to presentations of contributed papers. The symposium will also include keynote addresses by Vincent Crawford and Ariel Rubinstein as well as a special invited session with Andreas Blume and Martin Dufwenberg.

Accommodation and travel Accommodation will be provided and paid for by the Arne Ryde Foundation. A limited fund for travel grants is available for participants without other funding. Participants who wish to apply for funds should inform the symposium secretaries when submitting their abstracts or applications for participation.
